First Aid Checklist

Disposable gloves
Small flashlight
Bite-proof gloves
Absorbent gauze pads (large and small)
Sterile, non-stick gauze wrap
Flexible bandage wrap
Adhesive bandage tape
Cotton balls
Cotton swabs
Oral syringe
Soft cone-of-shame (use to prevent licking wounds - <u>use only if vet approves</u>)
Towels/blankets
Povidone iodine wipes or swabs (use to disinfect cat wounds and sterilize supplies)
Styptic powder (anti-hemorrhagic that slows minor bleeding)
Sterile saline solution (for rinsing wounds)
Instant cold compress packs
Small bottle of distilled water (for drinking)
Liquid, dye-free children's Benadryl
Safety scissors (with blunt end)
Tweezers (with blunt end)
Collapsible pet food/water dish (only give food/water IF vet-approved)

NEVER use alcohol/alcohol prep pads, human eye drops/ointments, OTC antibiotic ointments, or any other non-vet approved medications on your cat!
